Sofa - Bed

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Please do not place hot, cold or wet materials on the surface, as it can affect the fabric and foam of the sofa bed.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage.
- Avoid sitting on the arms.
- All fabrics are prone to snags caused by sharp edged materials. In case you notice snags, trim them carefully using a scissor. Under any circumstance avoid pulling them out further.
- Do not expose the product to direct sunlight for longer
- Accumulated dirt may dull the colour of the upholstery, therefore a weekly cleaning with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner is recommended.
- Do not bleach in any case while washing the upholstery.
- Extreme spills and stains should be cleaned by professional upholstery cleaners only.

Sofa

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Please do not place hot, cold or wet materials on the surface, as it can affect the fabric and foam of the sofa.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage.
- Avoid sitting on the arms.
- All fabrics are prone to snags caused by sharp edged materials. In case you notice snags, trim them carefully using a scissor. Under any circumstance avoid pulling them out further.
- Do not expose the product to direct sunlight for long.
- Accumulated dirt may dull the colour of the upholstery, therefore a weekly cleaning with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner is recommended.
- Do not bleach in any case while washing the upholstery.
- Extreme spills and stains should be cleaned by professional upholstery cleaners only.

Leather Sofa

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
 - Please avoid exposure to water, steam, prolonged moisture and direct sunlight
 - Keep sharp objects away from the sofa to avoid a tear on the leather upholstery.
 - A weekly cleaning with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner is recommended to prevent the fibers from snagging.
 - Avoid any spillage of food and drink. In case of spillage, treat it immediately with required attention.
 - In case of a stain, a water-free fabric cleaner is recommended.

Lounge Chair

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Please do not place hot, cold or wet materials on the surface or else it can affect the fabric and the finish of the chair.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining. Do not bleach in any case.
- Avoid standing on the chair or sitting on the arms.
- All fabrics are prone to snags caused by sharp edged materials. In case you notice snags, avoid pulling them out further, instead trim with a scissor carefully
- Do not expose the product to direct sunlight.
- A weekly cleaning with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner is recommended.
- Removable sofa covers and cushions should be given for professional dry cleaning as required.

Chair

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
 - Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining. Do not bleach in any case.
 - Avoid standing on the chair or sitting on the arms.
 - All fabrics are prone to snags caused by sharp edged materials. In case you notice snags, avoid pulling them out further, instead trim with a scissor carefully
 - Do not expose the product to direct sunlight.
 - A weekly cleaning with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner is recommended.
 - Removable cushions should be given for professional dry cleaning as required.

Dining Chair

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Please avoid direct contact of any hot, cold or wet material with the wood, instead use coasters or mats.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining.
- A wax rub-down in every six months is recommended for solid-wood furniture.
- Avoid standing on the chair as it might break
- Do not lean on the dining chair.

Pouffe

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- All fabrics are prone to snags caused by sharp edged materials. In case you notice snags, avoid pulling them out further, instead trim with a scissor carefully
- Do not expose the product to direct sunlight for longer.
- A weekly cleaning with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner is recommended.
- Removable covers and cushions should be given for professional dry cleaning as required.
- Do not bleach in any case while washing the upholstery.
- Extreme spills and stains should be cleaned by professional upholstery cleaners only.

Coffee Table - Solid wood

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Use of coasters or mats is always suggested while keeping hot, cold or wet materials on the surface.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining.
- Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning to avoid scratch on the surface.
- Do not sit/stand on the table, it may break.
- Do not keep the furniture near a window or any other place where it can be exposed to direct sunlight in order to avoid fading of polish.

Coffee Table - Glass Top

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
 - The glass may crack when exposed to sudden temperature variations.
 - Use of coasters or mats is always suggested while keeping hot, cold or wet materials on the surface.
 - Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining.
 - Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning to avoid scratch on the surface.
 - Do not sit/stand on the glass table, it may break.
 - Do not keep the furniture near a window or any other place where it can be exposed to direct sunlight in order to avoid fading of polish.

Coffee Table - Stone Top

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Use of coasters or mats is always suggested while keeping hot, cold or wet materials on the surface.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining.
- Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning to avoid scratch on the surface.
- Do not sit/stand on the stone table, it may break.

End Table - Wood/Glass /Stone

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Please ensure to use coasters or mats while keeping hot, cold or wet materials on the surface or else it can affect the polish/finish of the furniture/break the glass.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid staining.
- Do not sit/stand on the stone/wood/glass table, it may break.
- Prolonged exposure to sunlight can fade the colour/polish of the product.

Halfway Table

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Always refer to the recommended weight limit for products.
- Do not keep hot materials directly on the surface. Instead, use coasters and mats.
- Prolonged exposure to sunlight can fade the colour/polish of the product.
- Do not sit/stand on the table, it may break.
- Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning as they may put scratch marks on the surface.

TV Table- Wood/ Stone/Glass

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Do not keep extremely hot materials directly on the surface. Instead, use coasters and mats.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining.
- Prolonged exposure to sunlight can fade the colour/polish of the product.
- Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning as they may put scratch marks on the surface.

Book-Shelf

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Always refer to the recommended weight limit for products.
- Use shelf for books and decor items only.
- Prolonged exposure to sunlight can fade the colour/polish of the product.
- Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning as they may put scratch marks on the surface.

Wine Cabinet

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Do not keep hot materials directly on the surface. Instead, use coasters and mats.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining.
- Please clean water spillage immediately as it may spoil the surface.
- Prolonged exposure to sunlight can fade the colour/polish of the product.
- Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning as they may put scratch marks on the surface.

Dining Table - Solid Wood

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Use of coasters or mats is always suggested while keeping hot, cold or wet materials on the surface.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining.
- Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning to avoid scratch on the surface.
- Do not sit/stand on the table, it may break.
- Do not keep the furniture near a window or any other place where it can be exposed to direct sunlight in order to avoid fading of polish.

Dining Table - Glass Top

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
 - The glass may crack when exposed to sudden temperature variations.
 - Use of coasters or mats is always suggested while keeping hot, cold or wet materials on the surface.
 - Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining.
 - Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning to avoid scratch on the surface.
 - Do not sit/stand on the glass table, it may break.
 - Do not keep the furniture near a window or any other place where it can be exposed to direct sunlight in order to avoid fading of polish.

Dining Table - Stone Top

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Use of coasters or mats is always suggested while keeping hot, cold or wet materials on the surface.
- Use a soft-dry cloth immediately in case of any spillage to avoid chance of staining.
- Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning to avoid scratch on the surface.

Dining Cabinet/ Side Board

- Prolonged exposure to sunlight can fade the colour/polish of the product.
- Use it for intended purpose.

Bed Care Instruction

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- Always refer to the recommended weight limit for products.
- Avoid keeping extremely hot materials directly on the surface; instead use a tray or mats to protect the bed.
- Avoid using harsh materials like scrub pads for cleaning as they may put scratch marks on the surface.
- Do not keep the furniture near a window or any other place where it can be exposed to direct sunlight in order to avoid fading of polish.
- Never wipe the furniture in case of a spill as it might blemish the polish. Instead sponge the spill.

Cabinet Care Instruction

- Please do not drag furniture piece.
- We recommend using a soft - dry cloth for weekly dusting.
- Never wipe the furniture in case of a spill as it might blemish the polish. Instead sponge the spill.
- To protect the finish, avoid applying abrasives or household cleaners on the furniture.
- Do not keep the furniture near a window or any other place where it can be exposed to direct sunlight to avoid fading of polish.
- Do not place lit candles or extremely hot materials on the surface, as the excessive heat may harm the polish of your furniture.
